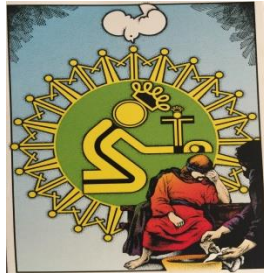


Lenten Thursday Evening Eucharist and Sacrament of Healing, 6:00 p.m.
and 7:00 p.m. Bible Study—ROAD TO CORONATION:



A Study of the Four Passion Narratives

Ash Wednesday is February 14—less than a month away. As you are making your plans for Lent, please consider the possibility of including **the Thursday evening Eucharist and/or the Bible Study**, which two of our assisting priests, the Revs. Ed and Sheila Fellhauer, will be offering at St. John's, beginning the first Thursday in Lent, February 15, through Thursday, March 22. The evening Eucharist will include the Episcopal Rite of Healing from the Book of Occasional Services with the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Unction for those who desire it. The six-week Bible Study is based on an approach similar to the course they led last year, except this year's study will be focused on the Gospels, and specifically on the passion narratives found in each of the four Gospels.

The Eucharist will begin at 6:00 p.m.. The Bible Study will begin at 7:00 and will end by 8:15. It is fine to attend either the Eucharist or the class or both. It is not a problem to participate in the study even if you know you will be unable to attend one or more of the sessions.

If you participated in last year's Lenten course, you will recognize some of the illustrations, graphics, and themes; however, this is a separate study that will give us all new insights as we make our journey with Jesus to the Good Friday cross.
